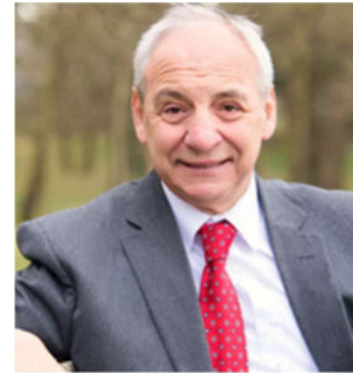

The SMART Flexible Innovation Support Programme is now open to any organisation with eligible projects.

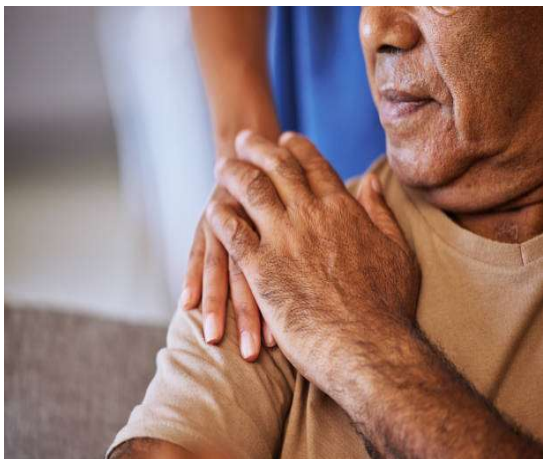

UP TO £30 MILLION INVESTMENT FOR COMMUNITY CARE

The Welsh Government will invest this money in delivering more care at home and in communities across Wales, helping to reduce the time people are spending in hospitals.

This investment will improve people's chances of living at home independently,

increase the use of technology and help to ensure that there are the resources and workforce available to support those people who are more frail to live at home.

This investment will also help to strengthen community services, helping more people

to recover safely and comfortably at home, instead of spending a long time in hospital.

Many older people in Wales have told us how important it is for them to be cared for in familiar surrounding with familiar people- this funding will help to do just that.

A PERIOD PROUD WALES WILL ENCOURAGE MORE WOMEN AND GIRLS INTO SPORT

Removing the stigma of talking about periods alongside improving the availability of period products at sports facilities will break down barriers women and girls face to participating in sports. As part of ongoing work in this area, the Welsh Government has committed £24M capital funding over the next 3 years to Sports Wales for developing inclusive sports facilities for all.
