Port Talbot Steelworks concern

The work force in Port Talbot has my sympathies; having worked there, I am aware of how important the steel making is to the town and wider community. I am also aware that many of my constituents work at the plant.

I have concerns about the rescue deal announced last week because Electric Arc furnace may not offer long term future for the plant. As I mentioned in my speech Electric Arc Furnaces are often mothballed because of the costs. Hydrogen offers a cleaner cheaper option for steel production. I recognise that it is not an option contained within the rescue package but it should still be considered as the technology develops.

I will continue to support the continuation of steel production at Port Talbot and I will continue to support the workers at the plant in whatever way I can.'
